### **Wifi**

Eduroam is available on campus. In case you cannot access eduroam, there is also a dedicated conference network. The network name is ICAME and the pin for access is icame.

### **Meals and refreshments**

Coffee and lunch are available every day of the conference and are included in your registration. If you want to explore Cambridge's local offerings, you're in luck - Anglia Ruskin is well placed for easy access to many cafés, delis, and restaurants. Highlights include Burleigh Street, Norfolk Street (especially the Norfolk Street bakery and Zonghua Traditional Snacks), and Mill Road - one of the best streets in Cambridge! (e.g. Fin Boys, Mill Mediterranean, Hot Numbers, Scott's, or if you just need coffee, Modigliani or Five Blends). A little further afield is Cambridge Market (on Market Hill), with a large array of food stalls that change daily.

### **Supermarkets and pharmacies**

The nearest small supermarkets are Tesco express on East Road and Little Waitrose on Fitzroy Street. The nearest pharmacies are Boots inside the Grafton shopping centre and Superdrug on Fitzroy Street.


